

fter months of work, meetings and discussion, Friends welcomed the completed *Old Maui High School Master Plan* - weighing in at almost two pounds! - with its site plans, evaluations and carefully-formed goals and policies which will provide guidelines for returning the once-neglected campus to new life and usefulness.

The professional planners, architect, surveyor, engineer and dozens of alumni and community supporters have produced thoughtful and technical proposals, phased in short, mid and long-term actions, which will be needed to complete the project, and establish the Patsy Takemoto Mink Center - "to create a unique and dynamic environmental education center that will be a show-place for sustainable living solutions."

Friends, working with Maui county administration and planners, has begun work on implementing the short-term actions listed in the Master Plan. To rehabilitate the entire "historic campus", including the existing school buildings, and have water, sewers, utilities and structures safe and ready for use by 2013, a five-year plan will be submitted to the County of Maui and other funding sources, public and private.

By the end of August, an implementation schedule, with cost estimates and feasibility studies, will be prepared, as requested by Maui Mayor Charmaine Tavares. To ensure this detailed schedule is initiated, and that funds are secured for the essential infrastructure projects, Friends will hire a Preservation Project Administrator, who will assist in coordinating the work with government and community providers.

If all goes well, by 2013 - the Maui High School Centennial Year - many of the short-term goals set in the Master Plan will have been met, and the beautiful campus, with its sturdy school buildings, will be ready again to instruct and inspire.

#### A MONUMENTAL PRESERVATION TASK BEGINS

In February, work was performed to halt deterioration of portions of the concrete Administration Building, where time and weather have caused rusting of old metal reinforcing ("rebar"), which then expanded and caused flaking ("spalling"), weakening parts of the window supports ("mullions").

The preservation work began with "brushblasting" --- a light blasting with specially-formulated abrasive, followed by careful hand-cleaning. Next two coats of epoxy were hand-applied to a specific thickness to all the exposed rebar. This complex and costly process, designed by project architect Glenn Mason, concrete experts and structural engineer, will help stabilize the condition of the eighty-seven year old landmark building, keeping further deterioration at bay until the next step in its rehabilitation -- Raising the Roof!

#### MHS DIPLOMA PROGRAM FOR WW II VETERANS

To recognize the brave veterans who served our country during World War II, Friends is proud to join with the Hawaii Board of Education in its program that will allow these men and women to receive their Maui High School diplomas if they left school prior to graduation.

After the outbreak of WW II, Hawaii schools were closed until February, 1942, and when they reopened, they had lost nearly a quarter of their teaching staffs and a large percentage of high school seniors. When the war ended and veterans returned home, many were not in a position to complete their high school education. Instead, they entered the workforce, raised families and led fulfilling, productive lives.

The BOE diploma program honors WW II vets and their families, by awarding them their high school diplomas. Friends has arranged with the Board to distribute and collect the required WW II Veterans Diploma Program Application forms, and submit them for review and issuance of the Maui High School Diploma.
